| ◆ Cross-cultural Experience | In light of the growing importance, frequency, and variety of cross-cultural exchanges, students are encouraged to enhance their international competitiveness by spending one or more semesters studying at one of the University’ s sister schools overseas. |
| ◆ Cooperation with Outside Organizations | The Department has developed strong cooperative relationships with a variety of organizations and enterprises, mainly in the areas of education, culture, international trade, and tourism, thereby providing students with a wide array of opportunities to deepen and diversify their academic studies. |
| ◆ Internships | The Department has formal internship agreements with a wide variety of organizations, including Hess International, TVBS Media, Pyramid International Tour, and AV-Jet International Media, etc. so as to increase student’ s experiences of putting learning into practice. |
| ◆ Career Development Seminars | The Department regularly holds career development seminars featuring talks by alumni and business leaders. Past speakers have included representatives of 1 1 1 Job Bank, Giraffe Cultural Enterprise, and Hess International, etc. so as to diversify students’ learning opportunities. |
| ◆ Service Learning | In order to enrich students’ practical experience and to improve the English ability of local children, the Department has formal student-teaching agreements with a number of nearby schools, including Tamsui Elementary School, Wenhua Elementary School, and Tiansheng Elementary School. |
| ◆ Dual Counseling | In accordance with the University’s vision on providing students with comprehensive guidance, in addition to a designated academic advisor, each student is required to choose an additional advisor who provides guidance in such areas as coursework, school activities, and social issues. |
| ◆ Further Study | Advisors provide students with guidance on applying to graduate programs in English and related fields in Taiwan and abroad.The Department has a detailed reference chart showing our course work and options for further studies. |
| ◆ Test Preparation | Language training and ability is the focus of the Department, and its past students have consistently had excellent scores on standardized tests of English proficiency—a major advantage when applying for a job or graduate school. |
